

Human trafficking

According to the definition of the United Nations, Human Trafficking means: "The recruitment, transportation, transfer, harbouring or receipt of persons for the purpose of exploitation." The victims are coerced into a position of dependence by their traffickers through

debt bondage, violence, and/or drugs. The victims become "exploited" goods and are deprived of their personal rights, freedom of speech, independence, and self-respect. It's not just foreign, poor people who are trafficked. Any age, class, religion, nationality, gender, or colour can be a victim of trafficking. Vulnerable people are more at risk, such as the homeless, minors, young adults, migrants, people working in prostitution, people belonging to ethnic minorities, children in foster care or homes, people living in poverty, people with disruptive home

lives, people in crisis or conflict situations.



Would you know how to identify a person who may be a victim of trafficking? Many people do not know the signs, such as: appearing scared, anxious, depressed, withdrawn and unable/reluctant to make eye contact; not being able to speak the local language; having someone who speaks for them or translates for them; being dressed inappropriately for their age.

More importantly, would our health care and other professionals know how to spot these and other signs, such as: unexplained injuries; having had multiple pregnancies/abortions; looking malnourished; not giving an address or saying they are just visiting; not having medical insurance?

Doctors and other health care professionals may encounter victims more often than they realise and are in a unique position to help. 85% of victims have had contact with a health care worker (doctors,

Answered prayer

A Finnish court has upheld the right to free speech by dismissing all charges against Finnish MP Päivi Räsänen and Bishop Juhana Pohjola. In a unanimous ruling the court concluded that "it is not for the district court to interpret biblical concepts".

After her victory, Päivi Räsänen said "I am so grateful the court recognised the threat to free speech and ruled in our favour. I feel a weight has been lifted off my shoulders after being acquitted. Although I am grateful for having had this chance to stand up for freedom of speech, I hope that this ruling will help prevent others from having to go through the same ordeal."

LATEST NEWS: Finland's public prosecutors have just announced that they will appeal the verdict.

dentists, primary care) while being trafficked, 80% in the first year. A survey of 1000 doctors showed that fewer than 10% of them ever suspected they had been in contact with a victim of slavery. Only 20% of these said they would know what to do if they encountered

a victim, what signs to look for, or what the laws and procedures are for reporting safety concerns.

The Red Alert Task Force is an organisation aiming to bring together professional people: doctors, surgeons, academics, political leaders, teachers, survivors of slavery and others who have a passion to educate, advise, change policies, and join in the fight against the injustice of modern-day slavery and trafficking. People from the task force will go into hospitals, medical schools, universities, schools,

businesses, governments, police stations and more to give training on modern day slavery/trafficking awareness, what it is, how to spot it and what to do.
