Hebron Europe Nations Gathering, 14 May 2022

Another ministry of Hebron Europe is to organise occasional online gatherings of people from different European nations, to worship and proclaim Jesus as our Lord and King. We did this in March 2021 and many said they felt God's presence very strongly so we knew He was pleased with it. I learnt that gathering in unity and love from many countries is very powerful and it gives us authority.

Two European Elections completed

With the Presidential elections in Hungary and France decided, where different views of Europe have won through, we must look to how Europe moves forward in continuing to balance the differing visions for this continent. This question is vital as Europe faces an uncertain future, not simply in economic terms and peace keeping within its borders that have dominated the last 7 decades, now more perhaps than ever before we need to be aware of our own vulnerability to global issues. How we address energy dependency, migration and food security will impact how Europe is both perceived and trusted in the future.

We plan to meet again on 14 May 2022. Sadly, this cannot be an open gathering for everyone to attend, because we want to concentrate on gathering representatives from as many of the nations of Europe as possible. But we would appreciate your prayer support!

Report on our Prayer Gathering in Skopje, 3-7 April 2022

As the 'European Union of Prayer' we have already met to pray in every capital city of the European Union. Then last year, God guided us to change the name to 'Europeans United in Prayer' and to hold our first gathering outside the EU in Skopje, Republic of North Macedonia. We were there two weeks ago, 3rd to 7th April, and had a really blessed time. We received a warm welcome from the churches and believers of Skopje and many of them joined our meetings. Altogether we were 25-30 people from 13 countries. God blessed our unity and there were some beautiful times of reconciliation prayer between people from different countries. We hadn't planned this but were delighted that God did it.

4. After this successful start, we need to plan the next few gatherings. Please ask for God's blessing and guidance on our planning and discussions.
5. The gathering incurred costs of about €1800, because Hebron Europe paid for the hire of the conference rooms and gave other support to the event. Would you be able to help us cover this cost? All donations would be warmly appreciated and details of how to give are at the bottom of this letter.

Additional Prayer Points:-

1. When everyone is concentrating on Ukraine, the enemy can work unseen in other places. Pray for protection for Israel at this time. Also, for the Ukrainian Jews who want to get to Israel.
2. Let us pray for the long-term effects of the French presidential election, on both the economy and vision for Europe.
