Revive Europe

27 December 2019 - 1 January 2020 saw more than 3,000 students, graduates and staff gather in Germany for the IFES Europe student evangelism conference. The 11th of its kind, this European student evangelism conference was bigger and broader than ever before.

It began with a dream: a vision of a generation coming together from every corner of Europe to pursue revival in the university world and beyond. United in this vision were representatives from more than 20 other Christian organisations in Europe who

A fresh attempt is being made by pro-abortionists in the EP to affirm a "right to abortion" and also to ban conscientious objection by medical personnel in the Matic Report. However, health issues are the sole responsibility of Member States and fall outside the competence of the EP. Past attempts to impose a common stance have therefore failed, but a Parliamentary Resolution is the expression of an opinion which Parliament wishes to make known and, although not binding in law, it would be a form of "soft law" intended to produce practical effects. Let's pray that this Resolution will be defeated decisively! Pray too for the Christian organisations which are leading the fight in this area and who have suffered fierce attacks in recent months.

university in the region, and considered what it looks like to bear witness to Jesus on campuses today. Finally, all 3,000 participants looked to the continent as a whole, praying for a fresh move of God across Europe.

As we prepare to come together at Revive later this year, we've launched the Revivalympics, a virtual prayer relay to help unite us in seeking revival across Europe.
